Matt Cuny is from the Sioux tribe in South Dakota and feels the call to work with the Native tribes. Also Jared Myrick (soon to be married to Vicki) is called to Alaska and is preparing for this field of service. Please pray for these laborers who are like-minded.



You may have heard of the tragic school shooting recently on the Red Lake Chippewa Reservation in northern Minnesota that left 10 dead. Although we knew no one there, our hearts were stirred to go. The Lord spoke to my heart, *“Where the plow has gone deep, be there to plant the good seed.”* Through a miraculous chain of events, the Lord opened many doors for us there. God led me to a troubled 16 year old Chippewa boy, named Robert, the first day. He told me of the terrible depression and hopelessness that dominates his people. He shared with me his own frustration, and desire to escape. His heart was ready to receive the message of new life and hope through Jesus Christ. He wanted to pray through right there! I told him, “The news of death spread across the country, but news of your new birth has reached heaven today!”

Andy invited me to his home for fried walleye and a Bible study. He was saved after a near-death drug experience with “bad meth.” Now he’s on fire for God!
