## WITHOUT EXCUSE

*Romans 1:20- so that they are without excuse.*

It is sometimes difficult for our finite minds to reconcile the mercy of God with the wrath of God as it is revealed to those

who have never heard the gospel message. Romans 1:18-32 deals with the wrath of God toward the heathen. This Gentile world had no law and no prophet, yet they face the great penalty of the wrath of God. Look at Romans 2:11-12. 11. For there is no respect of persons with God. 12. For as many as have sinned without law shall also perish without law: and as many as have sinned in the law shall be judged by the law. We see in this passage that man is not condemned by or for his knowledge or ignorance; instead, he is judged by sin. How could anyone say that a man who has not heard the gospel is without excuse for the way he lives his life? Romans 1:19-20 gives us four reasons why man is without excuse even though he is without the law.

The first reason man is without excuse is his conscience. Verse 19 says Because that which may be known of God is manifest in them; for God hath shewed it unto them. The ability to know God is bound up in the make up of man. Note the attempt of the

heathen society to govern themselves. What tells them there is right and wrong? Where did the thought of righteousness and evil come from? Look at the idolatry of the worlds without God. Where did the concept of worship come from? Verse 19 reveals to us that they come from within. It is manifest in them. This ability to know God and the awareness of a higher power that comes from within is our conscience. The idea of righteousness, evil, and God's holiness is revealed to every man, Bible or no Bible, in his conscience. Romans 2:14-15 illustrates this point perfectly. 14. For when the Gentiles, which have not the law, do by nature the things contained in the law, these, having not the law, are a law unto themselves. 15. Which show the work of the law written in their hearts, their conscience also bearing witness, and their thought the meanwhile accusing or else excusing one another;). If the Gentile can be justified by the inner law and confirmation of the conscience, then they are also condemned by that same law and conscience.

Next, Romans 1:20 declares that God has not only revealed himself from within by the conscience; he has also revealed himself from without by Creation. 20. For the invisible things of him from the creation of the world are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made. The irrefutable fact that God has revealed himself in and through his magnificent Creation leaves man without excuse. God in creation reveals the invisible through the visible. A man who lives in this world, with all of its beauty and splendor, receives a revelation of God each day. Look at the migrating birds, the planets in their courses, the sea with its boundaries, the budding and blooming of the plants: they all testify of God to mankind. Christ himself said, "consider the lilies of the field, consider the fowls of the air"; creation preaches the gospel message. For man to find God, all he needs to do is

**ARTICLES of FAITH**

The enemy had caught David away from home and destroyed Ziklag, the city where his families were. They had taken David's wives and children captive and carried them away. David and his men that were with him cried so much that they had no more power to weep. David's men got so upset that they talked about stoning him because they were so grieved over their own sons and daughters.

David saw this but he had God on his side (don't speak of his failures, God has cancelled these out.) So David encouraged himself in his God. He told Abiathar the priest to bring out the Ephod, something we can't hardly understand today. The Ephod said to pursue and you will get them all back, so David pursued with six hundred men. They met an Egyptian who

was sick, who had no food or water for three days and nights and they fed him. He took David and his men, after David promised not to kill him, to these kidnappers and David found them eating, drinking and dancing for joy. They had taken all that belonged to David and his men and were rejoicing over their loot. David smote them from the twilight to the evening of the next day. David and his men got them all back (1 Sam. 30:19). This is the Easter issue, and the Devil and his Mob (the Jews who had the Romans crucify Jesus), thought they had him put away forever, but up from the grave He came! I expect by the grace of God, (we should always say by the grace of God) to see all of you in heaven. I do know that His grace is sufficient -what could be more encouraging than that! Enough said!

look around him. No wonder Paul says, "Thou art inexcusable O man." Science attempts to reason God away. They say there is a reasonable explanation for nature's phenomena; however, when a man reasons God from his creation, he not only rejects him with his mind, but he rejects him with his heart. The fool hath said in his heart there is no God. God is clearly seen and understood by his creation.

Next, man is without excuse because of God's power. God not only reveals himself from within by conscience and from without by creation, but Romans 1:20 also shows God revealing himself from above. 20. Even his eternal power... Time and again God has displayed his power in His Word for everyone to see. Consider the parting of the Red Sea, seen, not only by the chosen, but also by the heathen. Remember the fire falling from heaven on Mt. Carmel, seen by God's prophet as well as the prophets of Baal. Such awesome displays of power are not exclusive to the history revealed in the pages of God's Word. His great power has been displayed toward Godless societies recently in typhoons, earthquakes, tsunamis, and volcanic eruptions. All of these are God displaying his power through things

that are made. The heathen are, have been, and will be without excuse, because God's power has been shown unto them.

The final reason, but not at all the least of the reasons, man is without excuse is God has displayed himself in person. Here again, is Romans 1:20. 20. Even his eternal power and Godhead. There need be no confusion concerning the Godhead. I have heard it said, "Attempt to explain the Godhead and lose your mind; explain it away and lose your soul." Man cannot escape the person or identity of God. The Godhead has been clearly revealed to all mankind. That revelation has come from God through his Holy Son Christ Jesus. Colossians 2:9 tells us that the fullness of the Godhead dwells in Christ. I understand that some have mistaken this to mean Jesus is the Father, The Son, and The Holy Ghost. I will not take the space to defend the doctrine of The Holy Trinity nor to refute the heresy of the aforementioned belief. We simply need to understand that man will be without excuse because God has revealed the Godhead in Christ to the world. 1 Timothy 3:16: And without controversy great is the mystery of godliness: God was manifest in the flesh, justified in the spirit, seen of angels, preached unto the Gentiles, believed on in the world, received up into glory. Christ, while among us, continually spoke of the Father and the Spirit as distinct from himself, yet the unity and nature of the Godhead is continually displayed through Christ. God has revealed himself to us in person.

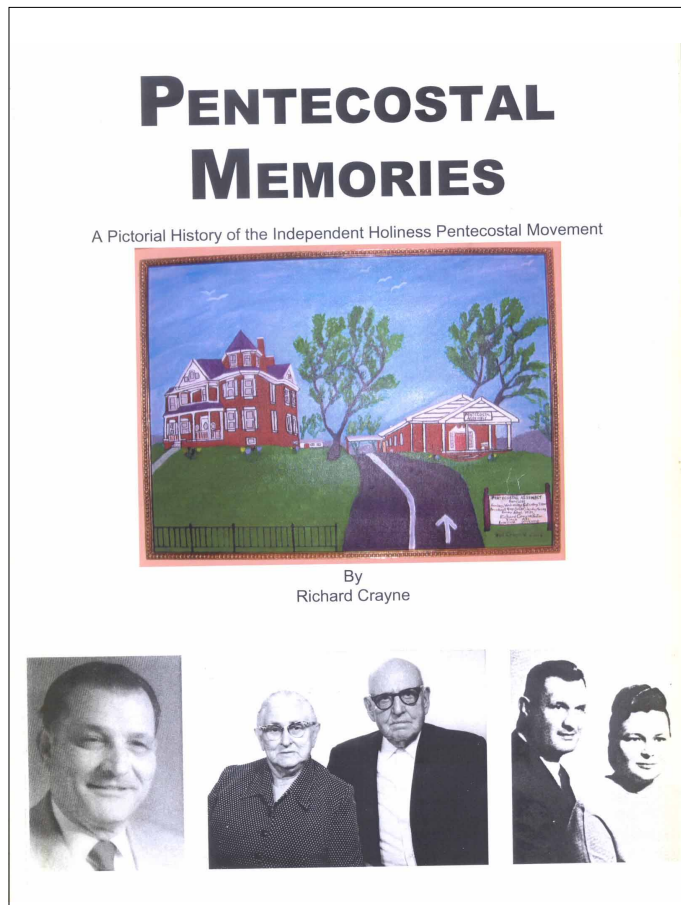
My point is this: If a man with no Bible or no preacher is without excuse before God, how much more are we without excuse with all the advantages we have in the so called Christian society we live in today? Matthew 22:12 illustrates my point and gives an appropriate closing. 12. And he saith unto him, Friend, how camest thou in hither not having a wedding garment? And he was speechless. It is understood that at the time of this parable, the custom was to provide a wedding garment to those present at the wedding. This man rejected the regal provisions and thus was speechless, or without excuse. Many will stand before the King of eternity having rejected his provisions through the things he has made and revealed, and, when the inquiry comes, they will be speechless. They will be without excuse.

### Does Your Rooster Have A Sore Throat?

I would like to start off by saying what an honor it is to be asked to speak to you. I also want to take time to thank everyone for their prayers in recovering from heart surgery. I received so many cards, letters, & phone calls. May God bless you.

Here we are at the most exciting time of the year for a Christian, the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ. In Matthew 26, there're several things that take place leading up to the death of Jesus. Peter was involved in two different scenes in this chapter. First, he makes a vow of loyalty to the Lord and tells him in vs.33, "*Though all men shall be offended because of thee, yet will I never be offended.*" He also says in vs.35, "*though I should die with thee, yet will I not deny thee.*" We must also remember the words of Jesus when he says in vs.34, "*Verily I say unto thee, that this night, before the cock crow, thou shalt deny me thrice.*" The second scene which involves Peter in this chapter is the one I want to deal with for a few moments.

Peter was asked on three different oc-

casions if he was with Jesus. He denies the Lord three times. As soon as he utters the words, "*I know not the man*", the bible says, "*immediately the cock crew.*" I don't believe it took Peter a long time to hear the rooster's crow. I believe he heard it the first time, and every time after that. He did three things right here, he heard, he remembered, and he wept bitterly.

Young folks, God has placed something inside each of us called a conscience. It's the sense of moral goodness of one's own conduct and intentions with a feeling of obligation to do right. In other words, let me be the first to tell all of you, "There's a rooster inside of you." Now I know that sounds funny but it's true. It's your conscience. No, you can't see it, but you most definitely can hear it. So my question to you is this, *Does your rooster have a sore throat?*

I know, I know, you say Deny Christ, NEVER! I go to church midweek, two times on Sunday, and we always pray over our food so my rooster's throat is loud and strong. However, what about those times when we are hanging with our friends and someone ask "How come you go to church all the time, and why do you dress like that?" Umm... my mom and dad make me? Cock-A-Doo-DEL-DO! Maybe it's, "Hey what about this joke?" Ha..Ha..Ha.. Cock-A-Doo- ... Music, what's wrong with that song? They say Jesus at least once, I think. Cock-a-doo-ahhhhhh... The once strong voice of your rooster has begun fading due to the constant usage. Before long the poor little rooster's voice will be reduced just to a small whisper and you won't hear it at all.

When birds are migrating in flocks to other lands, and the instinct is strong upon them, if you catch one and imprison it in a cage, it will beat its breast against the bars and pant back and forth. But let the migratory season pass, and you can open the cage and the bird will not fly. You may even take it and throw it up into the air, but it will fall back limp to the ground. The tug on that little heart is gone. For a

soul, for a nation and I suppose even for a world there comes a time when the tug of the Holy Ghost at the heart may pass forever. That's why it's so important to respond to the crowing when it's heard.

We are living in a time when there're to many young men & young ladies that are using their consciences like they use a wheel barrels, they just roll it wherever they want it to go. I wonder if there're any of you out there that your poor rooster has been crowing & crowing & crowing until his throat is sore. He's took cough drops. He's drank hot tea. He's done everything he could to get you to remember what God's Word has said, but you just keep ignoring him. We read in the Bible, "*He that hath an ear let him hear.*"

My family & I live next to the weather siren, it doesn't matter what you're doing in the house when that siren goes off you can hear it. That's the way we need to be with our conscience, no matter what we are doing, make sure we can hear it. The stronger the rooster's crow the better off we'll be. Acts 24:16 says, *And herein do I exercise myself, to have always a conscience void of offence toward God, and toward men.* And you thought exercise was just to work out your physical body, however there's such a thing as a spiritual work out. The rooster can't do it all by himself.

I'm sure there are times when you look around and wonder what's happened to so many of our friends? The truth is their rooster kept crowing until its throat became so sore it couldn't be heard. I Tim.4:2 states, *having their conscience seared with a hot iron.*

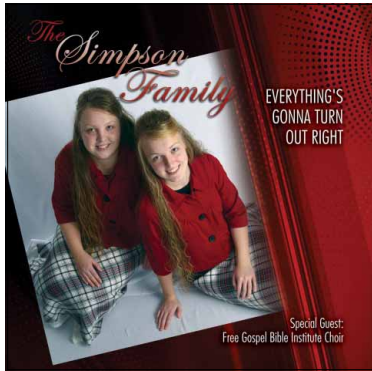
So what do you say we give the old rooster a break, and respond to his crow the first time? Always remember this one thing; a crow from our rooster is needed however crowing over & over again is not.

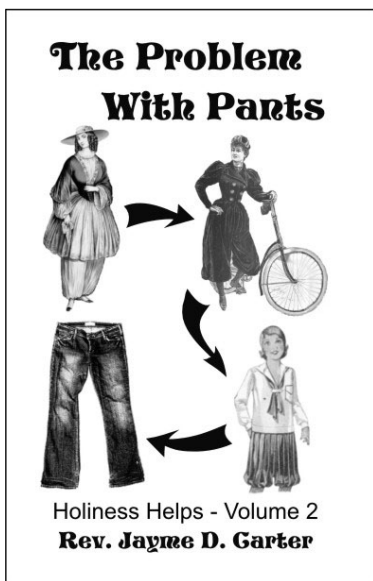
There is nothing better than family harmony. I have known these folks for a long time and they live what they sing. Another touch that makes this
